

My Dear Friends,

On April 30 a large congregation witnessed the Confirmation of 18 members of this parish. A Confirmation service is always an event of great importance not only to those who are being confirmed but to all church people because it reminds us that we also have solemnly dedicated ourselves to the service of God and have received the Gift of the Holy Spirit. 

VICAR'S LETTER.

My Dear Friends,

We are anxious to compile as complete a list as possible of the Communicants in the parish. Last Easter a large number of you received Easter Cards but I know that there are many whose names are not yet on our Communicants' Roll. If You are one of these will you please send your name either to me or to Mr Fonistone. I believe also that there are a few people who will wish to be Confirmed next year. Of course there will be no Confirmation in Totley Church for some time but I shall be very glad to form a class next winter and to present them at the nearest convenient centre. It is not too soon to begin to think about it now.

The School Re-building Fund grows steadily and it is hoped that the actual work will be carried out next summer. In addition to the amounts stated below, we have been promised a sum not exceeding £100 by the Derbyshire Association of Church Schools. The EXACT amount will depend on the final estimate of the cost. I am glad to say also that the re-flooring of the big classroom is to be carried out during the next few weeks. I should like also to assure all those who are concerned about the provision of better school buildings for their own children who are approaching school age, that the quickest way of obtaining this object is to help us as much as they can. If the church were to abandon the effort to save the school, no doubt a new council school would be built SOMEDAY but not until the population of the district had reached a very much higher figure than at present. On the other hand the improvements to our Church School will be begun almost at once and will only be limited by the amount of money at the managers' disposal. Parents who are thinking of their own children, can help them best by helping us.

VICAR'S LETTER.

My Dear Friends,

This letter is not a sermon, but as it is my first message to you all since the outbreak of war I will begin it with a text which may very well sum up our duty as Christian people at this time. "Though all this be come upon us yet we will not forget Thee". For most of us our normal life is interrupted and dislocated. We have new duties, new anxieties, new problems to fill our thoughts, but we must not let anything cause us to forget God and our duty to Him. Surely it is at such a time as this that our religion is put to the test and if it is true and real and sincere it will survive the trial. War is a hideous evil but at least it provides unusual opportunities for the exercise of faith and hope and charity and brings us all face to face with those deep things that matter most of all. Our need of God's supernatural help is greater than ever and the efore our devotion to Him-our prayers-our communion—our worship are of supreme importance. More than ever we must "cast all our care upon Him". More than ever we must "seek His kingdom and His righteousness".

It is inevitable that some changes shall be made in our timetable. Please note especially that Evensong on Sundays will be at 3 p.m. and make it known to others. I hope all of you will try to attend at this altered hour. Also note that evening meetings previously arranged are cancelled. Baptisms will be either on Weekdays or at 4 p.m. on Sundays. (Notice must be given in all cases.) For the present no choir practices are being arranged. The church is open daily for private prayer and I hope many will use it. (The church room will be open for emergency use as a shelter if required and should give considerable protection at least from anything against which it is possible to shelter at all.)

Finally let us as Church people try to give a lead in cheerfulness, friendliness, and quiet courage. The old slogan was "Trust in God andkeep your powder dry"—here is a new one "Trust in God and keep your gas mask handy!". But above all "Trust in God".


